Job Purpose

To develop practical skills and knowledge in all aspects of technical theatre by working as part of the Venue Technical teams at Theatr Clwyd. Based at our nationally renowned producing house in North Wales, the Creative Industries Theatre Technician will support the delivery of high-quality technical services for both visiting and in-house productions. Under the supervision of experienced staff, this apprenticeship offers structured learning and development and hands-on experience in Lighting, Sound & AV, and Stage.

Key Responsibilities

Training and Development

- Participate in structured training across technical disciplines as part of an apprenticeship programme at Theatr Clwyd.
- Learn from experienced technicians and supervisors in a supportive and inclusive environment to build industry-relevant knowledge and skills.
- Active participation in online and in-person learning and development opportunities provided by partner organisations The Mackintosh Foundation and Chichester College.

Practical Support

Undertake practical work in relation to get-ins, fit-ups, strikes & get-outs
including the assembly, rigging, adjustment and use of scenery, props, rigging
and lifting equipment, lighting and sound equipment and special effects.

- Help with manual handling operations such as the loading and unloading of equipment from touring and production vehicles, or transport of equipment between our storage areas and performance spaces.
- Support technical operations during live performances, such as followspotting or backstage crew work, under guidance.
- Gain skills and experience in specialist theatre making disciplines such as LX,
 Sound and AV through supporting on Theatr Clwyd productions.
- Help maintain the theatre's technical equipment and report any issues to Deputy Venue Technical Managers.

Health and Safety
